Gutter companies who want assistance in implementing effective safety and health programs to prevent injuries and illnesses that may result from exposure to hazardous workplace conditions & work practices can get it from a free consultation service largely funded by the Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA). The consultation program not only addresses immediate problems, but also offers advice and help in maintaining continued effective protection.

This service is confidential. Your name, firm and any information about your workplace, plus any unsafe or unhealthful working conditions that the consultant uncovers, will not be reported routinely to the OSHA inspection staff. In addition, no citations are issued or penalties proposed as a result of a consultation.

When a consultant helps set up or strengthen a workplace safety and health program, safety and health activities become routine considerations rather than crisis-oriented responses.

The Bottom line the consultation program will:

- Help you recognize hazards in your workplace.
- Suggest approaches or options for solving a safety or health problem.
- Identify sources of help available to you if further assistance is needed.
- Provide you with a written report that summarizes these findings.
- Assist you in developing or maintaining an effective safety and health program.
- Offer training and education for you and your employees at your workplace and, in some cases, away from the site.
